Our instructor will bring a **live cow** to your school to help your students learn first-hand how milk gets from the cow to the container. The **Mobile Dairy Classroom** engages two outdoor assemblies lasting approximately 30-45 minutes, and is geared for primary grades *and* upper grades, so all students can participate! This program integrates **Language Arts, Math and Science**, while teaching about agriculture's contribution to our food supply and providing your students with knowledge of healthy food and activity choices. The assembly is designed as a morning program to allow us to return the cow for her afternoon care and milking. Please note that a minimum of 300+ students is required and dates are scheduled on a first-come, first-served basis so call early for your date.
