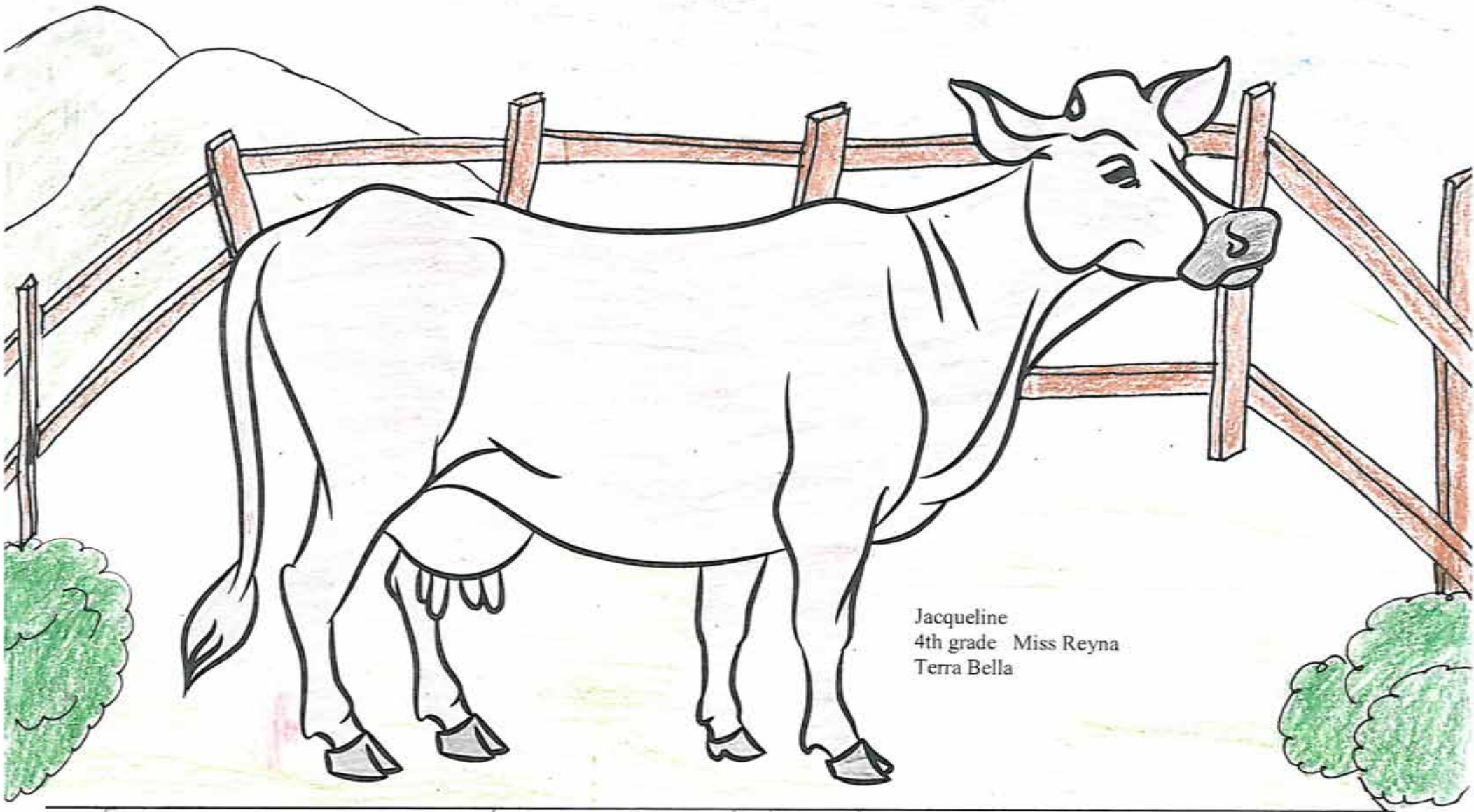


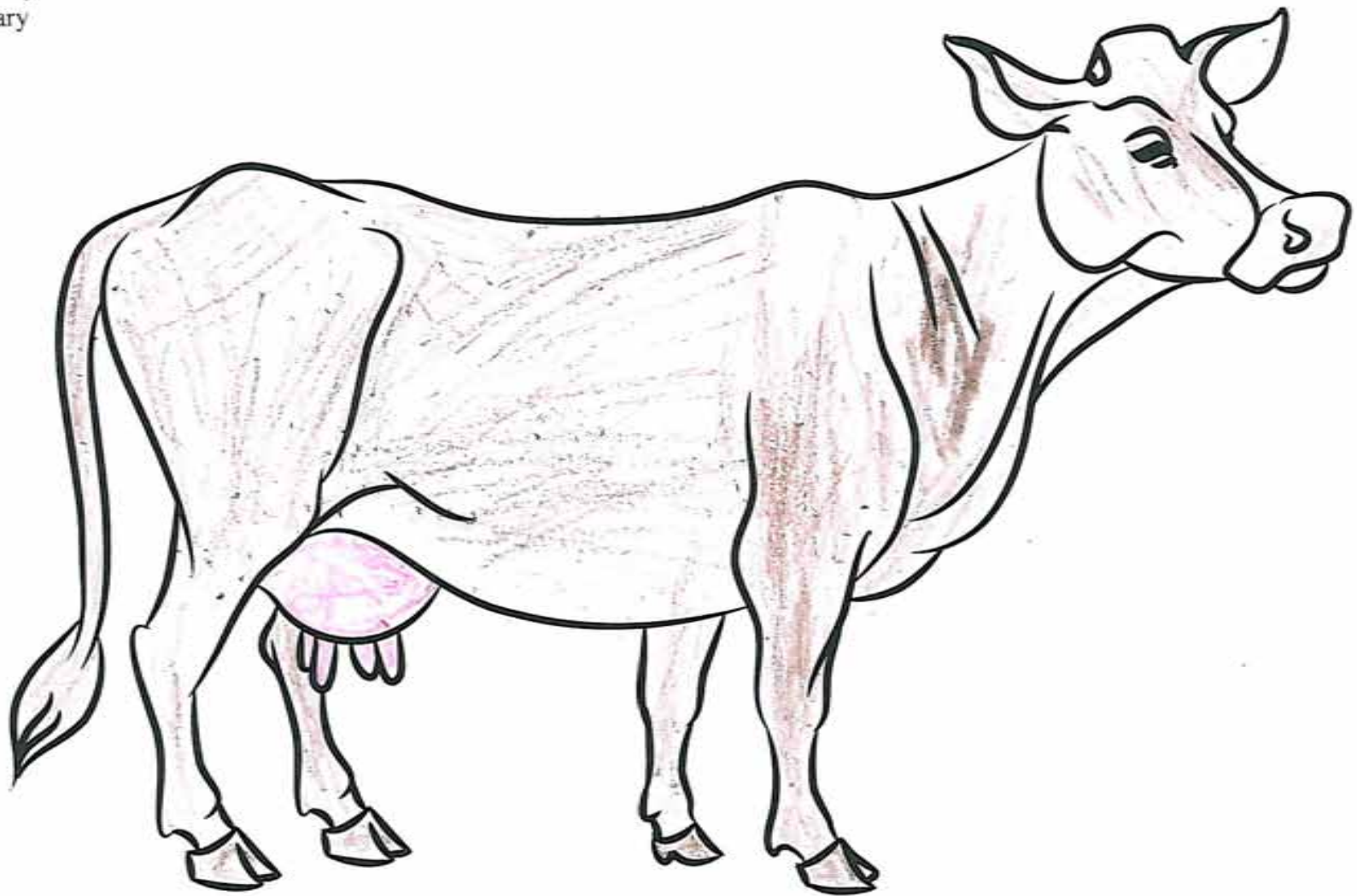

day. There is four parts in a cow's stomach.

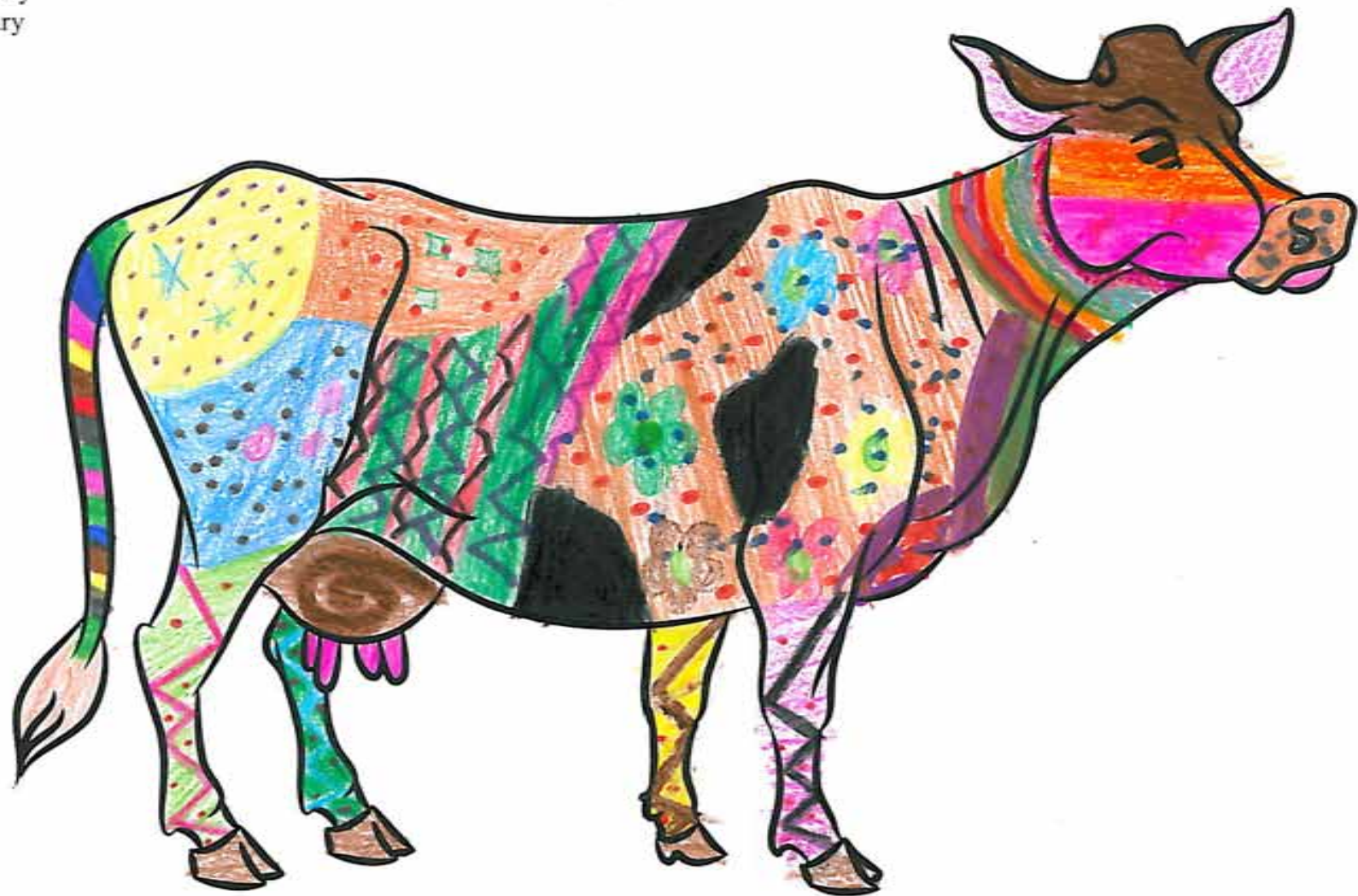

each side.



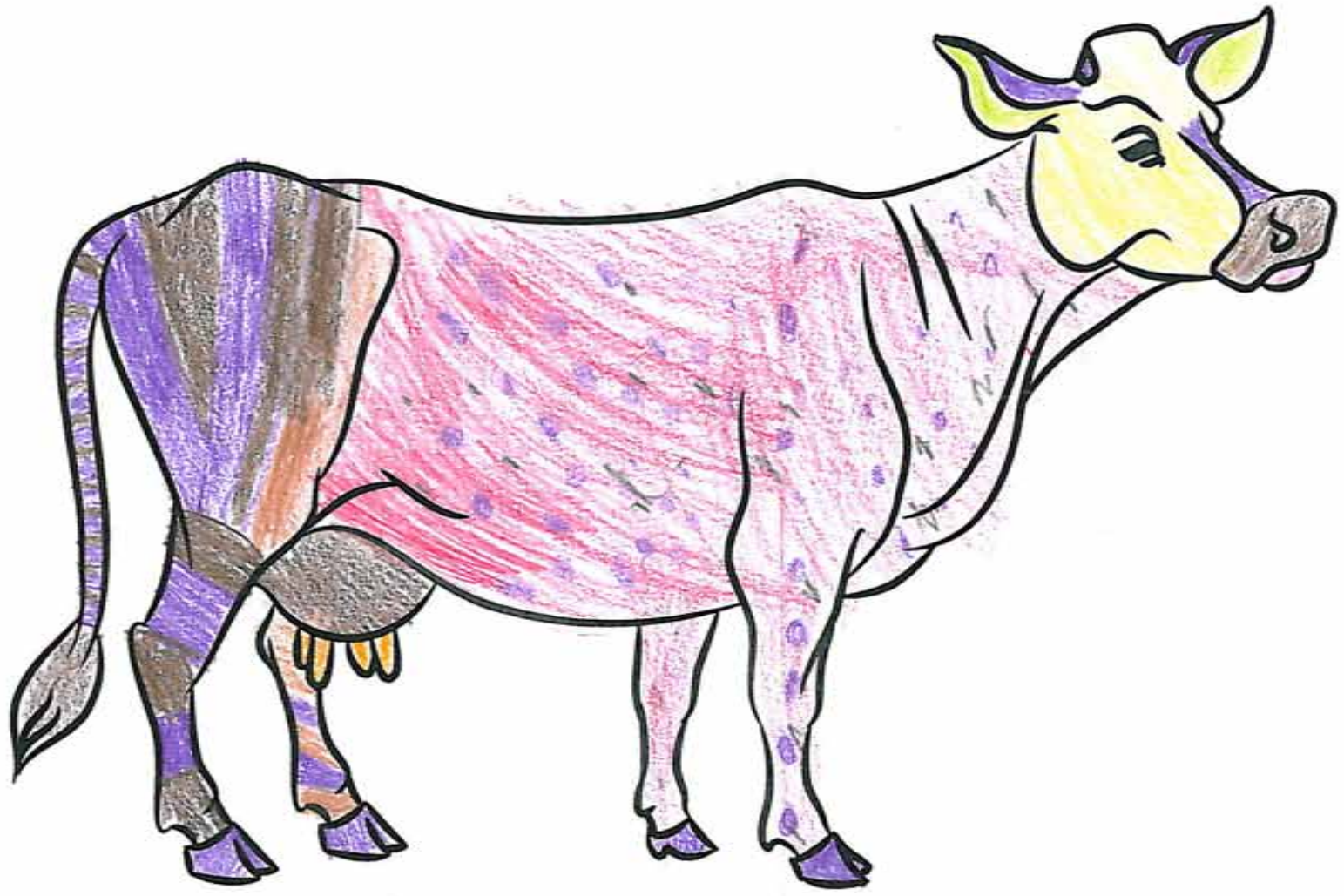
The Jersey cows have lot of

called calves.



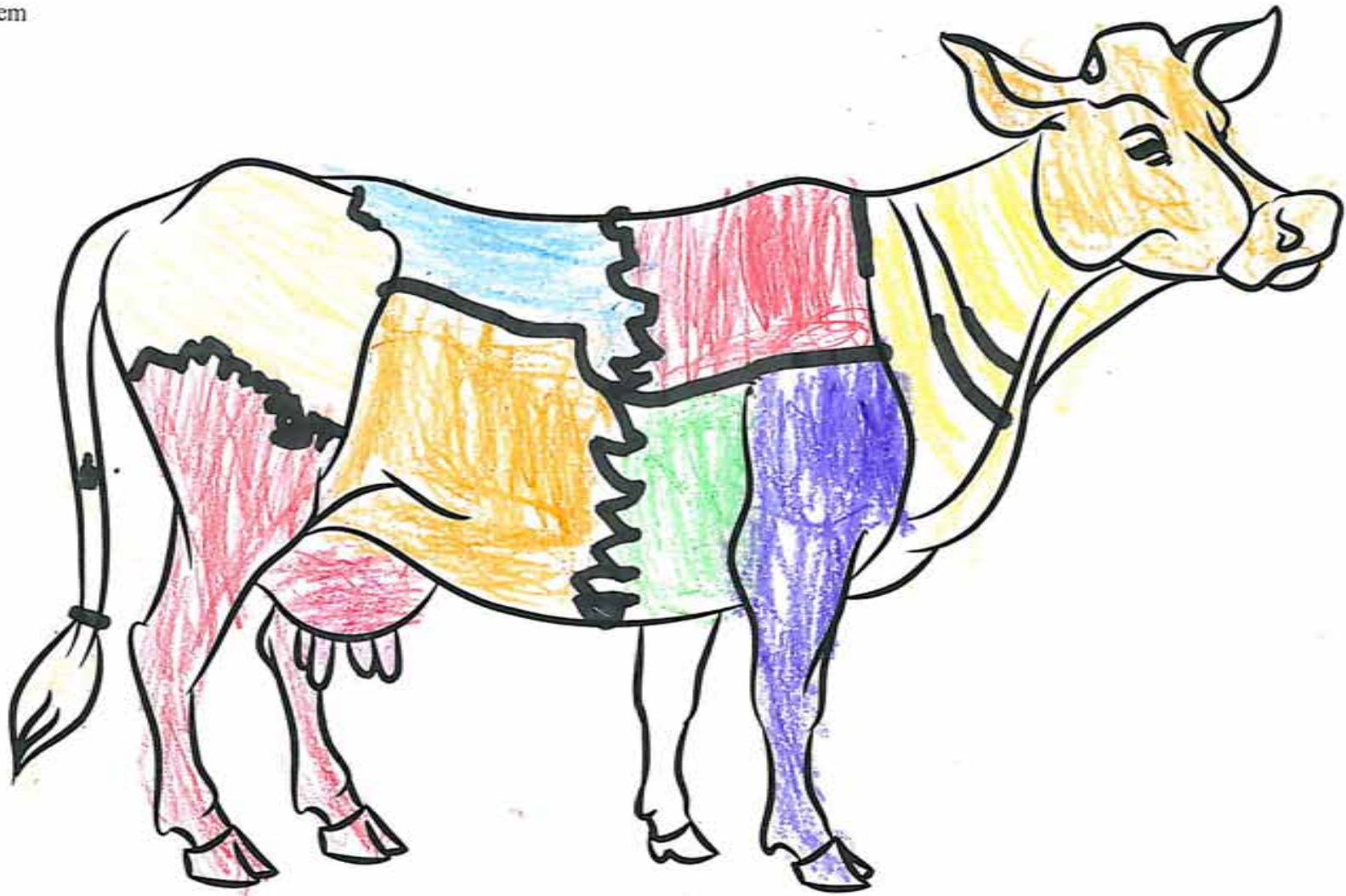
Cows can only be milked after

cows.



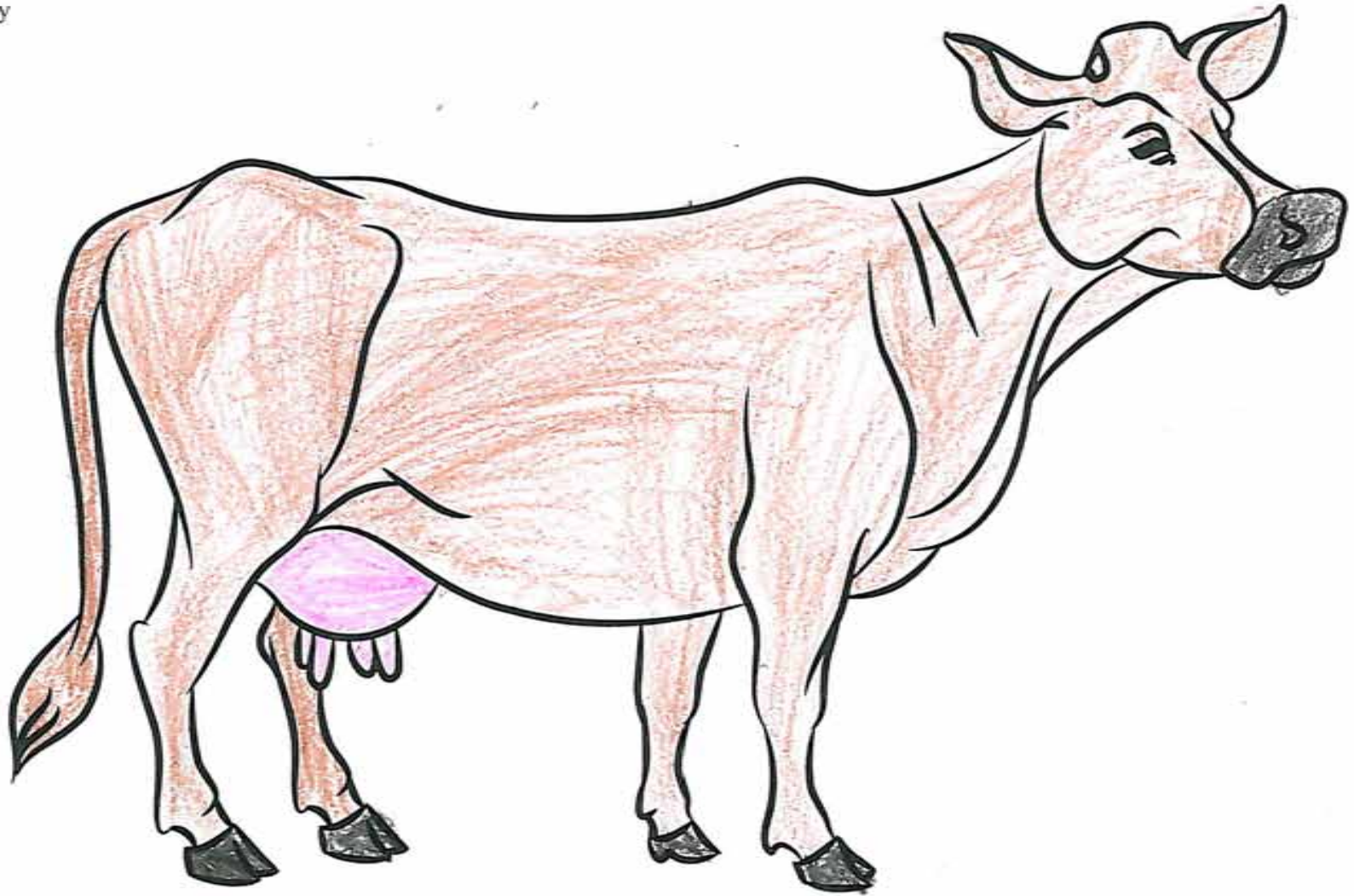
Today, I learned that a baby cow is

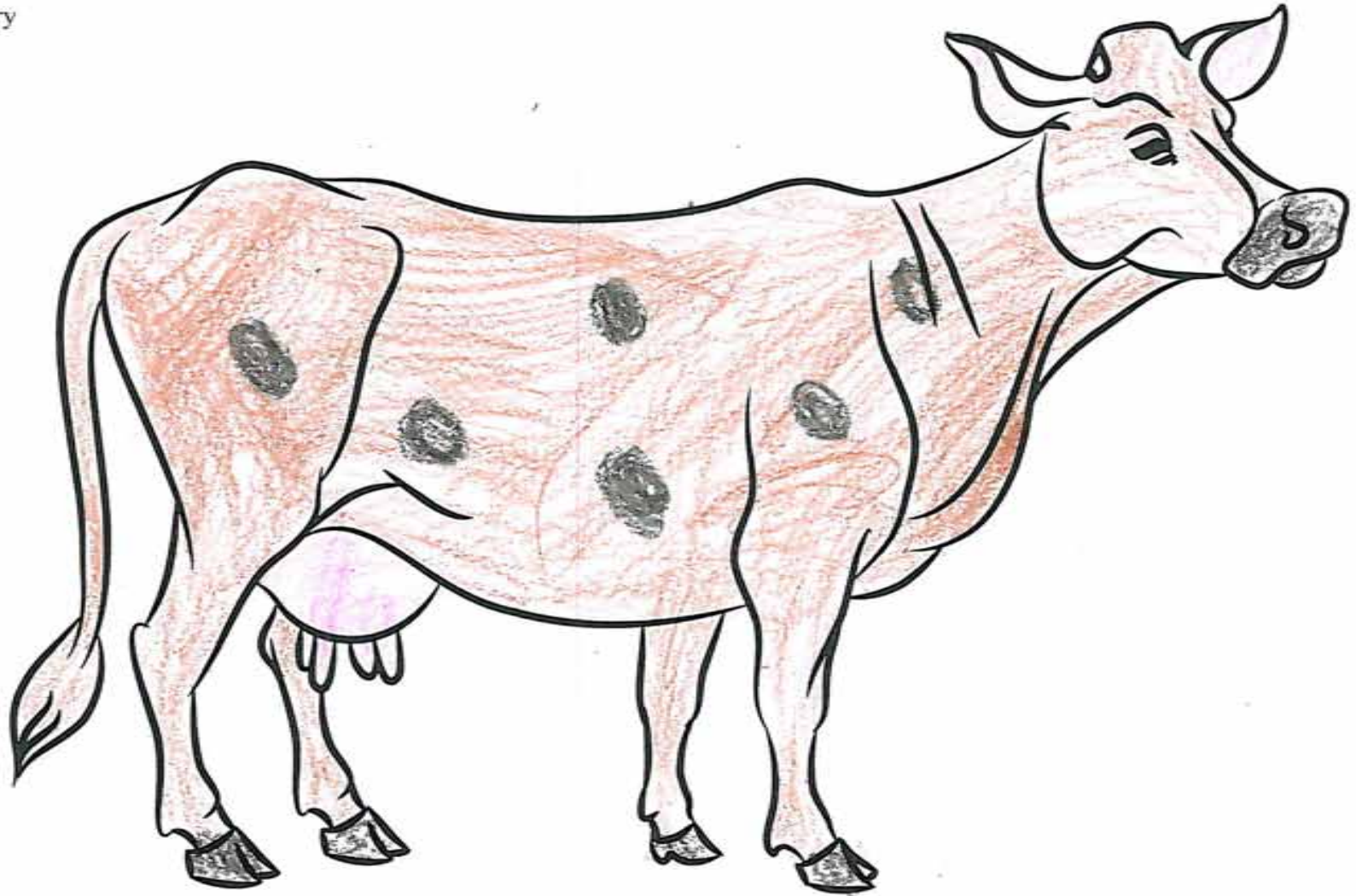

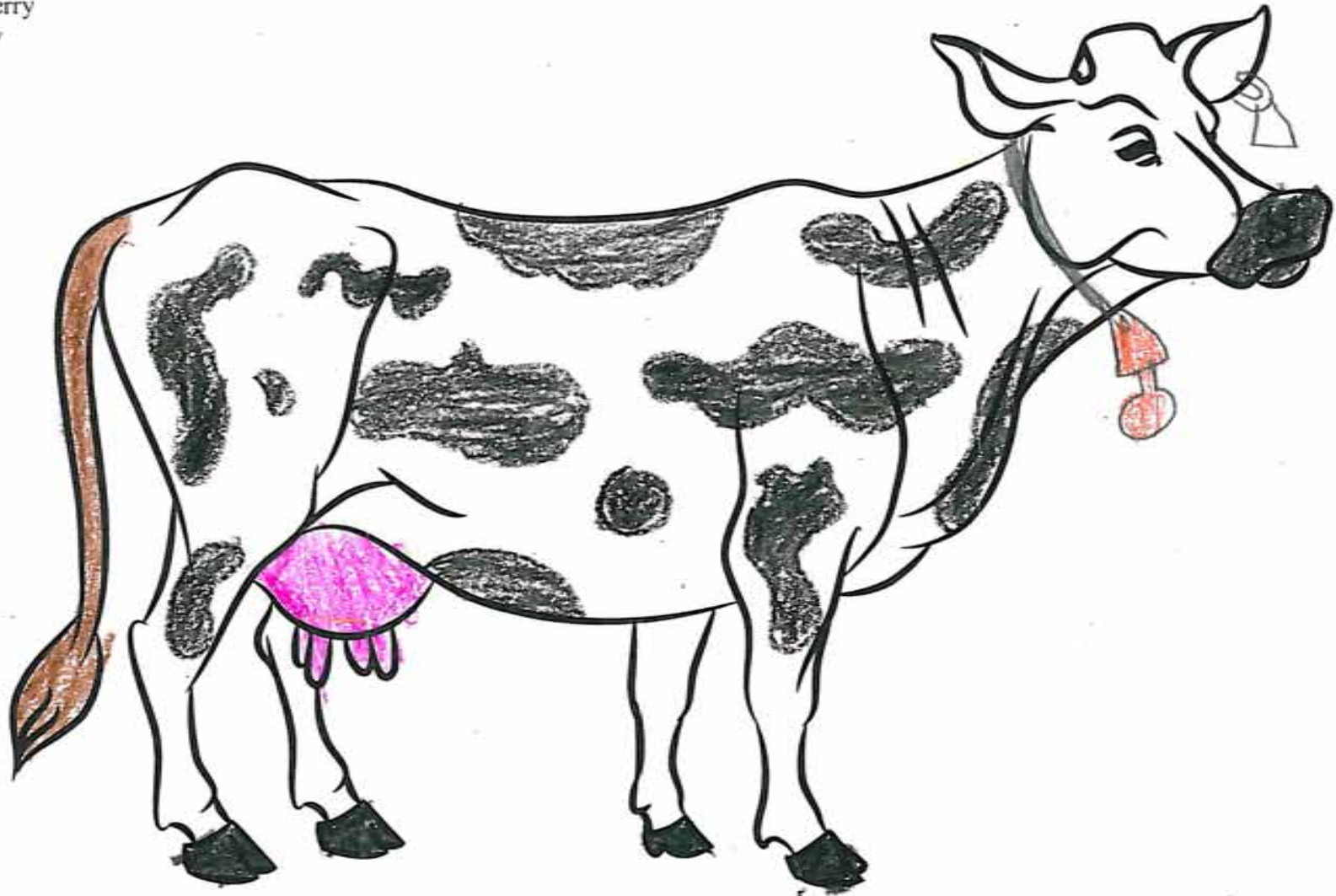

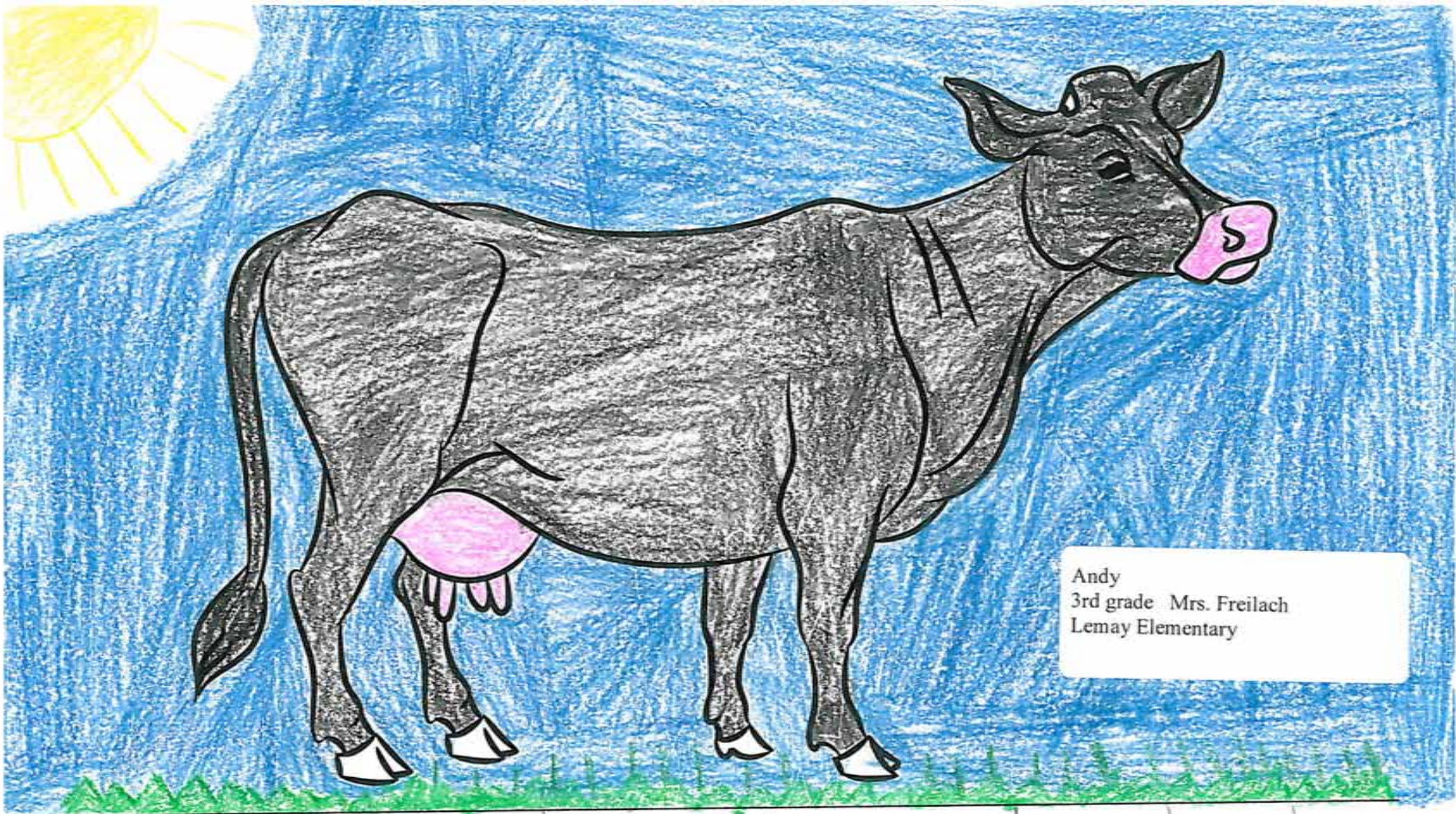


Dairy cows make milk, cheese, yogurt,
