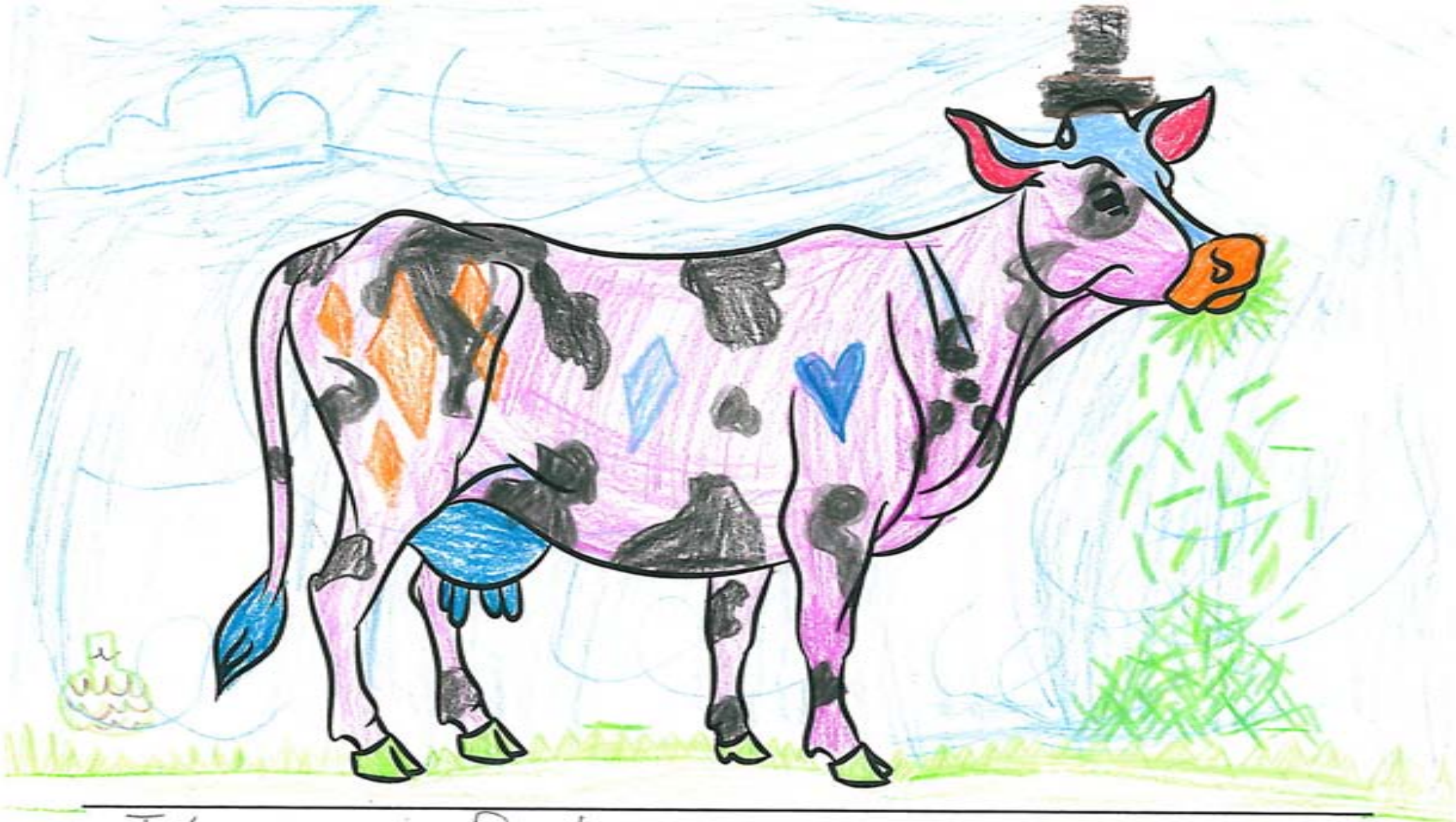

drink.



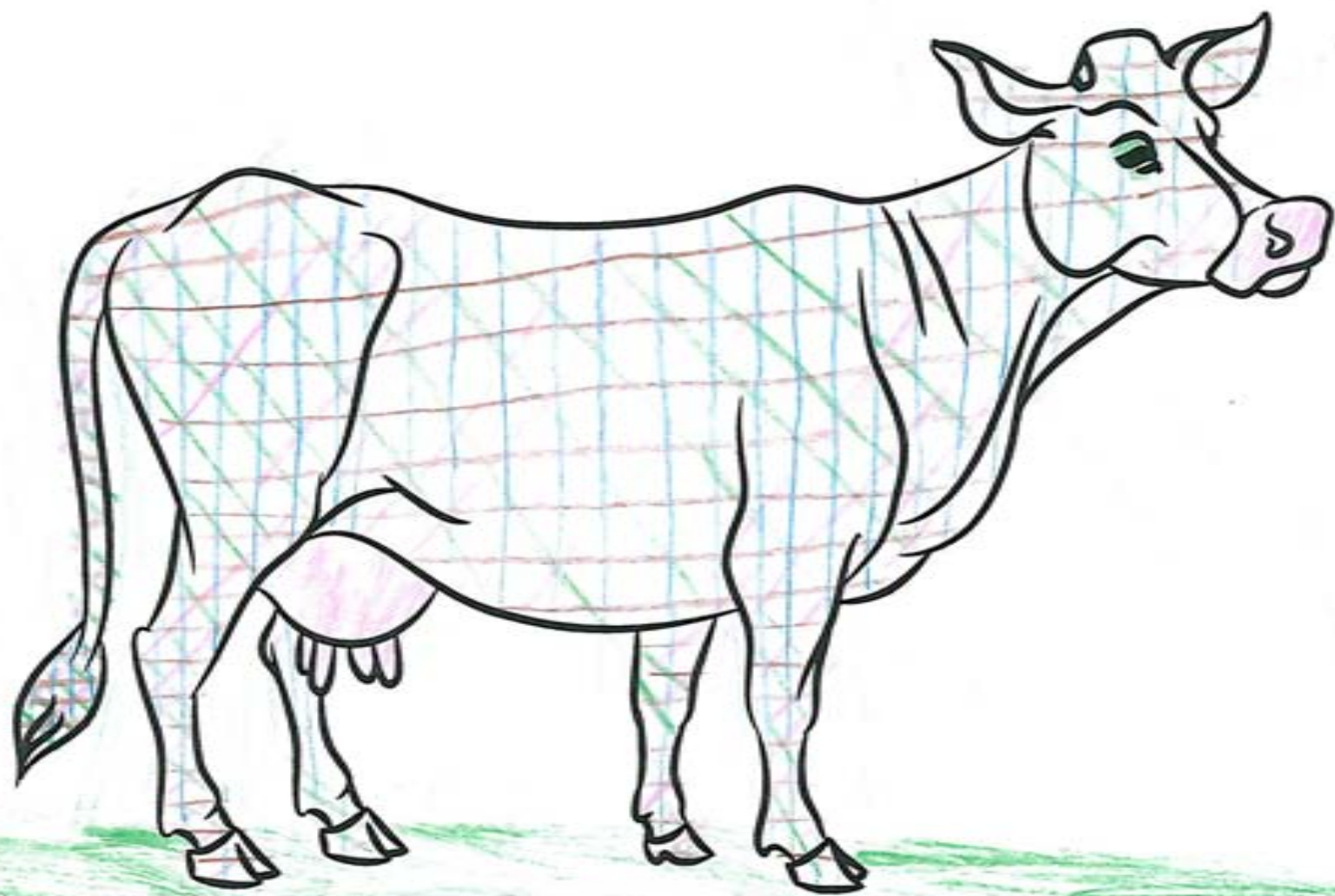
I'm a full grown male cow.

I'm called a bull. I also

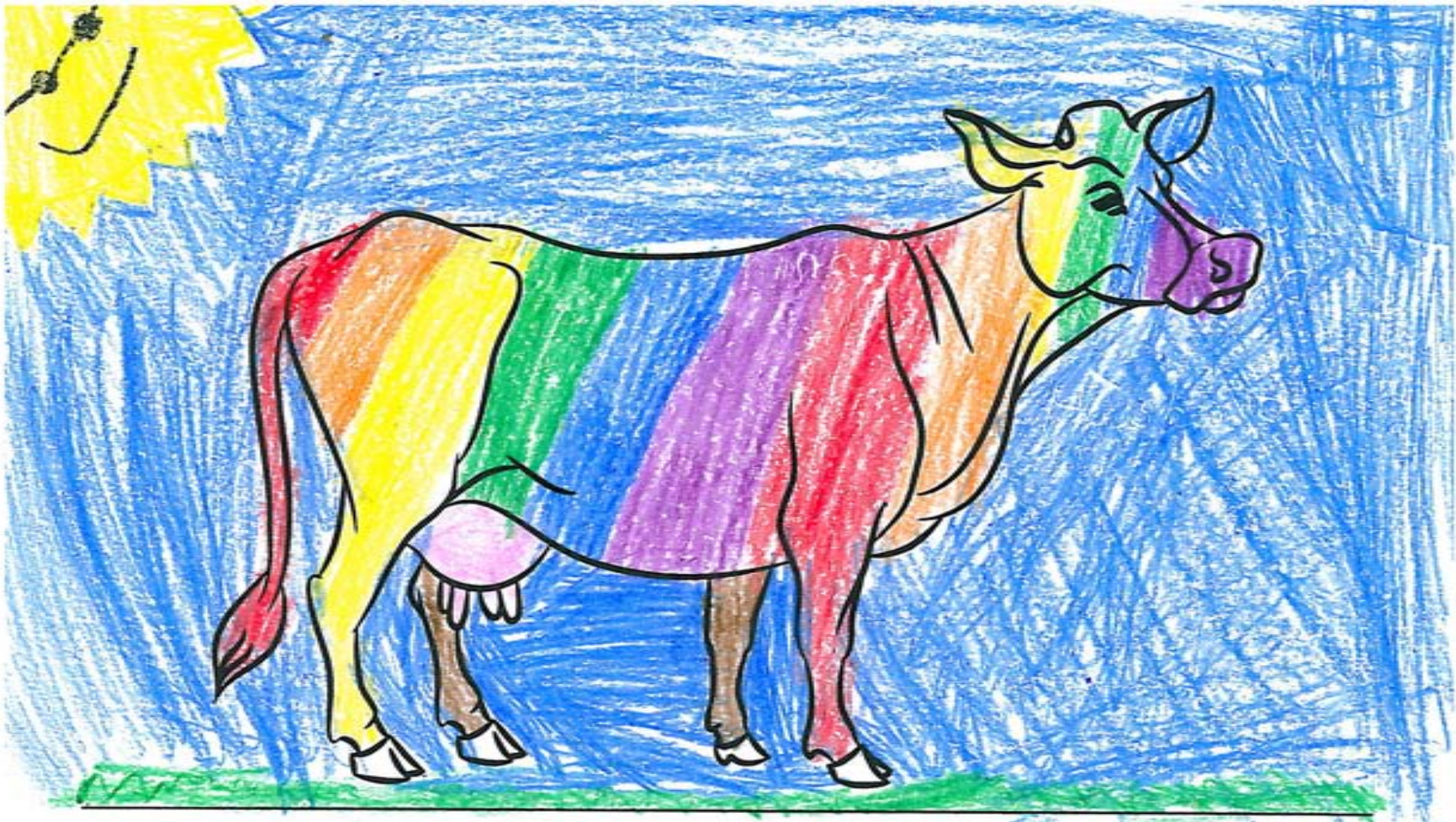
learned a baby cow is called a calf.



I learned that they cut off their horns when their six months old. I also learned that the cow has 32 teeth.



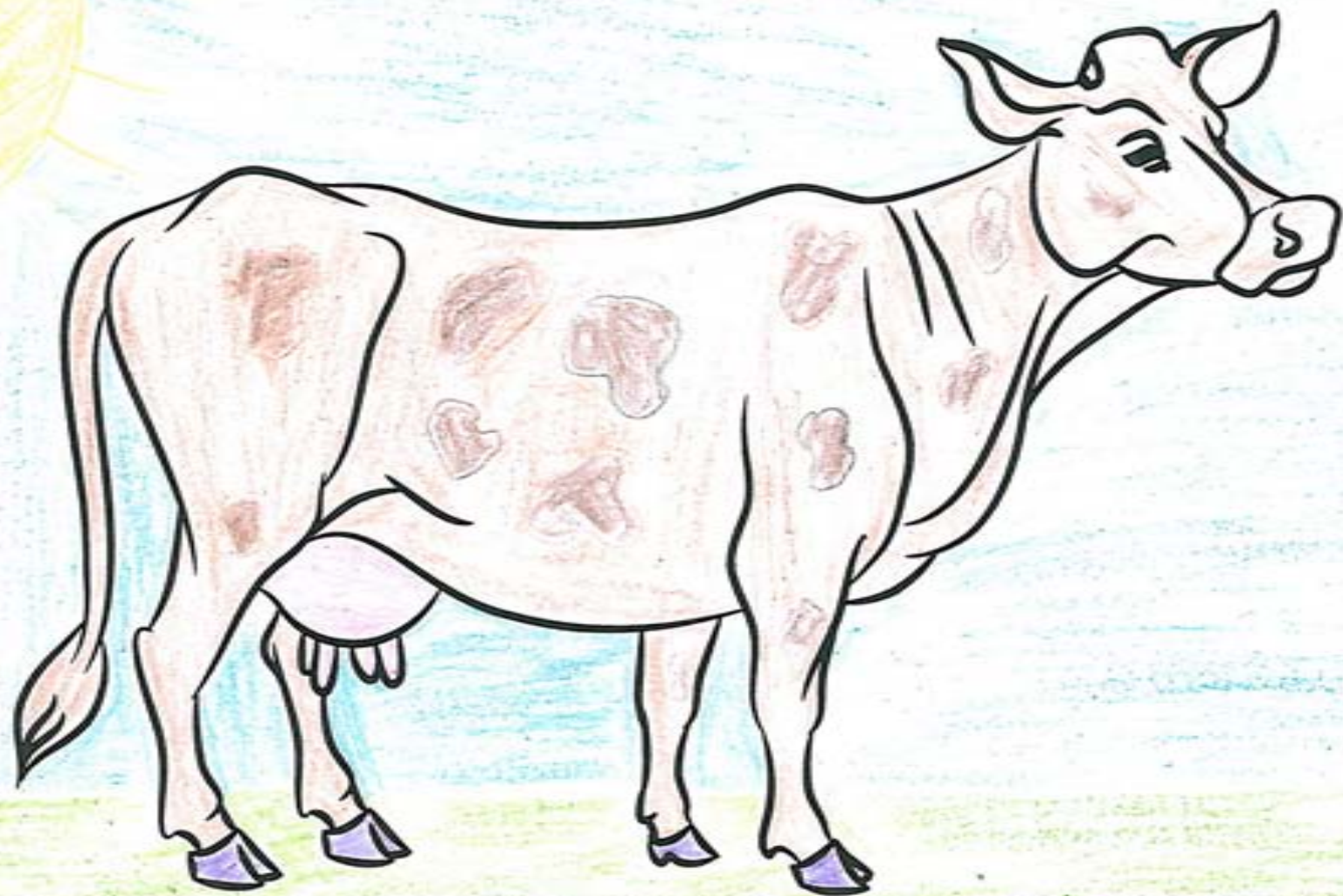
I learned that calves start to walk

to milk a cow. A calf needs to be fed warm milk.



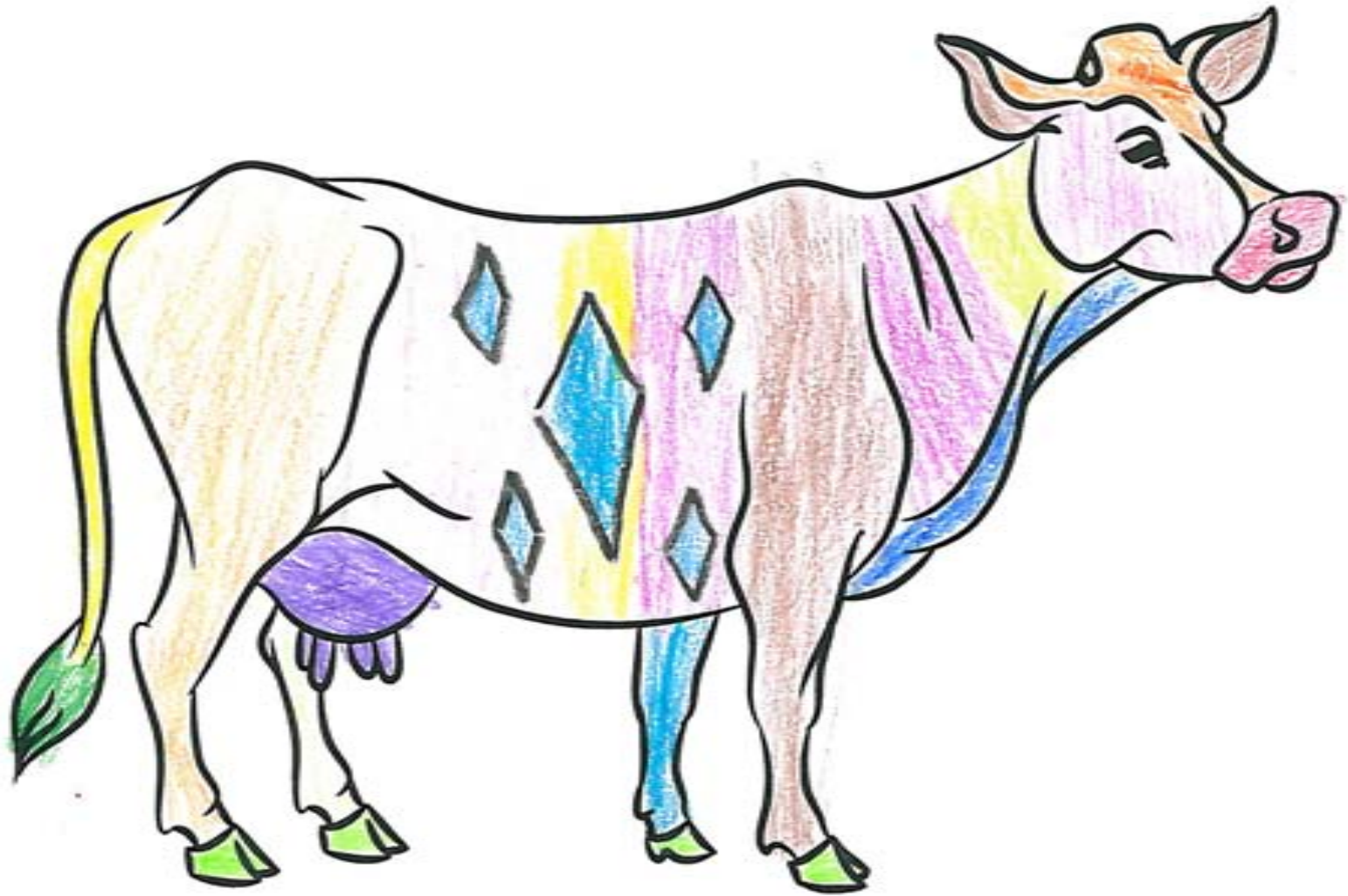
One fact I learned is that when cows are happy they
